

Coastal Biodiversity Survey

Voucher specimens were collected from 12 survey sites between November 2002 and July 2003. Sites sampled between 2001-2002 were sorted into regional groups based on biological similarity. Representative sites were chosen for the voucher collection. A sample of each species included in the Survey data was collected. Invertebrates collected are preserved in 95% ethanol and are housed at the California Academy of Sciences. Sensitive species were not collected, large species such as sea stars and anemones were photographed instead of collected.
